

Curriculum of studies –information and explanations for medicine students. Study program : students are incorporated to our ED/Erasmus groups and only study program is offered (not practical training/rotations) Additional explanations for our curriculum:

3 rd year	Clinical propaedeutic courses (internal diseases, pediatrics,)	The courses are introductory (patient's examination, semiotics, basic differential diagnosis) and it is important to have this knowledge completed when you need to participate in our 4th, 5th year clinical courses.	
4 th year	General Surgery	winter semester propaedeutic of surgery, general surgery	summer semester general, vascular and gastrointestinal surgery

Many courses consist of 2 semesters program : winter (1st part.), and summer (2nd part). To complete whole year program and to receive ECTS student must participate in whole year program (winter + summer).			
5 th year	General Surgery	general and oncological surgery, gastrointestinal surgery	
5 th year	Internal diseases	full year: cardiology, endocrinology, hematology, environmental and clinical emergencies, rheumatology	
5 th year	Pediatrics	cardiology, endocrinology , hematology-oncology	
	Psychiatry	only one semester program (3 ECTS) is available for Erasmus students in winter semester	
5 th year	Gynecology and Obstetrics	(gynecological and obstetrical pathology – diagnostics and treatment) – only for advanced students. 4th yr summer semester 1st part is introductory.	
<p>All courses here are confirmed as “credited with mark”. You can find in our curriculum description: “GRADE” – it means lectures and classes credited with mark, and sometimes additionally “EXAM” – it means final exam (not all our courses have final exam).Optional courses might (!) be available (1 optional/semester). However, there is certain number of students required to form the group and if the group is completed additional students cannot be accepted. Furthermore, I call your attention that elective courses are available to a limited number of students and are not always started. We cannot guarantee that you can join those courses! It is possible to apply for 1 or 2 optionals!</p>			

In 2019/2020 our curriculum should change for 4th yr (“modified study program”) : we expect that for example Medical Genetics, Dermatology, Infectious diseases 1+2 will appear. Public health, Neonatology, Toxicology in 2019/2020 will not be available here!

You can put into Your learning agreement our 1-5 yr subjects and optimally (to avoid overlapping) is not taking different year level courses .

To obtain whole subject ECTS (in semester/year) subjects like surgery, internal diseases, pediatrics should be taken in totality during winter semester or summer semester.

If You decide to take selected parts only from the above mentioned subjects, you will receive proportionally less ECTS.

Clinical rotations (traineeship program)

In the academic year 2017/2018 our new study program was implemented on the 6 yr (as practical year) and that’s why we have limited possibilities to accept students for many courses, especially internship program. In this situation we do not recommend to take here internship program longer than 2 months.

In practice all members of our didactic staff participate in regular didactic activity (ED and Polish classes, lectures, seminars) and it is very difficult to fix clinical rotations in the days of classes. We must look for not overcrowded clinics to find a place for rotation and it means that it is not possible to fulfill strictly detailed students needs. Our University standard is 2 months traineeship program (maximal 3 months) and for incoming students with long traineeship program we can offer our regular 6 yr program (in ED/Erasmus groups – whole semester program).
